





Create an Eventbrite

Manage your holiday party with a couple of clicks on Eventbrite. Make planning easy by having your guests register for your event—they'll get all the information they need in one place, and you'll know how many people plan on attending. Any last minute changes will be communicated directly to your attendees. How easy is that?

Eventbrite

- 1. Login. Go to Eventbrite.com and login to your existing account. If there is no account for your property, click "Sign Up" and create your page using your property email address and a password you will remember.
- **2. Update** your new login information in Bozzuto Link.
- 3. "Create An Event" to get started
- **4. Fill in the form** with your event title, venue name (i.e. property name and amenity), date and time
- **5. Fill in "Event Details"** with everything your attendees will need to know about the event, and what they will experience. Include images and videos to make this section seem more lively. Be sure to include contact information just in case people have questions. Use the "Add FAQs" button to be proactive about questions people may ask.
- **6. Fill in organization/host** with your property name and any relevant details about your property
- 7. **Link it up**. Add links to your social media pages by clicking the "Include a link to my Facebook page." Do the same for other social media platforms.
- 8. Create tickets by selecting the type of ticket you will be selling. Name all ticket types you have created so that attendees know what they are purchasing. If it is a complimentary ticket simply writing "Free" will convey this.
- **9. Promote Your Event**. This portion of the form allows you to change your privacy settings. By default it will be a public event.
- **10. Design.** Play with colors and images in this section with the preset themes or create your own. Choose to show your attendee list to the public or keep it private.
- 11. Make Event Live by clicking the button in the upper right corner.
